Programs & Services

- Adoptions: 20/dogs, 7/cats
- Pet Help Call Line: 500 calls received & handled
includes assistance scanning 3-4 lost/found pets weekly w/most bypassing the municipal shelter
- Micro-Chips: 7,650 registered - 2014-YTD
- Humane & Environmental Ed: 178 sessions
- Cans 4 Critters: \$8,640 helping 182 animals with “chip-ins” for medical- 2012-YTD

Activities Summary

During January–May 2019, HSSNM provided resources for community cats, with traps and trapping assistance for TNR as well as aid in transport and finances for spay-neuter surgeries. HSSNM also provided ground transport for animals to area rescues and to the Las Cruces and El Paso airports for animals going on “freedom flights” organized by Uncaged Paws with Dog is My Co-Pilot.

Representatives of HSSNM attended monthly meetings of the ASCMV board, meetings of the Coalition for Pets & People, and meetings of the Animal Care Task Force (to update language in the animal care ordinances). Board President Frank Bryce served on an interview panel for Dona Ana County Animal Control to fill a position of “Live Animal Evidence Technician”.

Board members have been guests on KTAL community radio “Animal Affairs” program and provided other educational outreach by staffing booths at the city volunteer fair and other locations including “Check the Chip”.

HSSNM board of directors hold work sessions at monthly board meetings, organize fundraising projects and events throughout the year for advancing the organization’s mission and for sustaining essential programs and services. HSSNM board of directors and members also support area animal welfare organizations with physical, technical, and financial help and attend their events and fundraisers.
