2020 Annual Report

Programs & Services

- **Adoptions:** 3 cats/16 dogs
- **Pet Help Line Calls:** 90-120 a month answered & assisted
- **Humane Education:**
 - 4 online education units w/28 participants (May1-Dec. 31)
 - 5 organizations awarded "Ally in Education" (\$50 each)
 - Fur'ever Friends & Critter Connection- 56 sessions (Jan.-March.)
- **Cans 4 Critters:** \$11,193 w/233 animals helped (2012-2020)
- **Micro-Chips** – 13,000 (2014-2020)

Other Services

- TNR support & transport of more than 40 cats for sterilization to Anthony vet clinic & shelter clinic belonging to colonies in the county, with some financial assistance & food support. Assistance includes registration of colonies.
- Trapped a lost, scared dog in Picacho Hills area & returned to owner. Support for trapping a stray dog to rescue.
- Assistance with spay-neuter cost for 2 dogs impounded at the shelter & reclaimed by owner.
- Assistance identifying a dog & returning to owner after dog's disappearance nearly 4 years ago.
- Accepted stray puppy in HSSNM foster program found at a convenience store by a caller to the pet help line. Accepted 4 dogs running at large into HSSNM's foster program (dogs found by Good Samaritans).
- Provided over \$200 for micro-chipping of 30 dogs from La Mesa accepted by Forever Homes Animal Rescue for rescue, transport & adoption.
- Made over a dozen calls to El Paso & Scottsdale animal organizations investigating records & accountability for an adopted dog erroneously listed as spayed.
- United animals through microchip scanning with their owners on an almost daily basis (4 dogs returned home in one day during Nov.)
- Registered hundreds of micro-chipped animals in collaboration with Mesquite Mobile Vet Clinic.
- Removed over 20 rattlesnakes from residences & relocated to natural desert environment.
